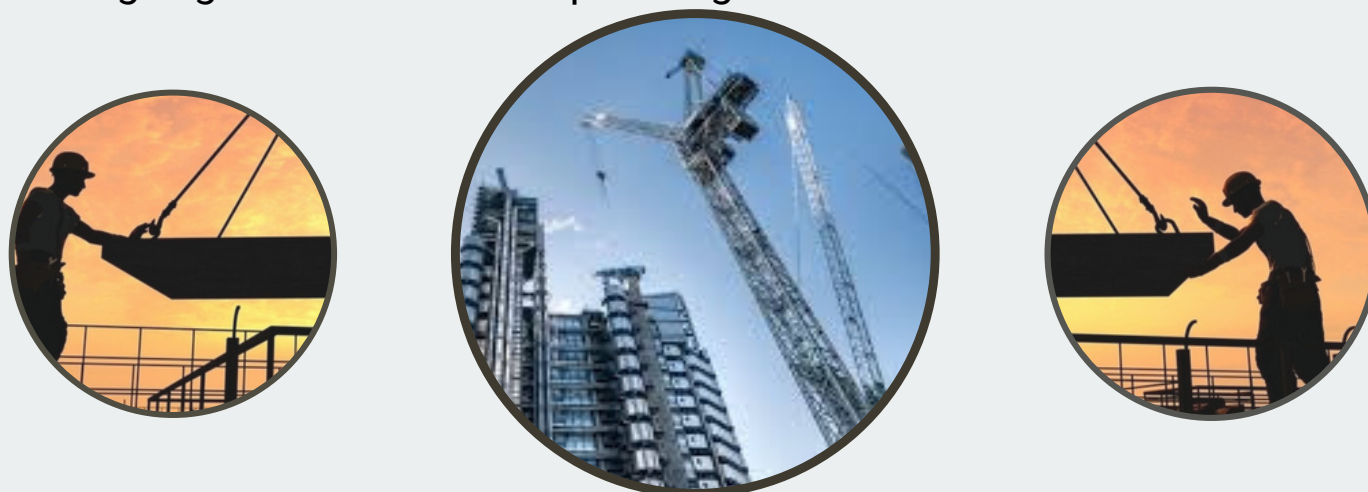


## About this Workshop **FIDIC Module 1A, 21 & 22 November 2019**
